SUBJECT: Bryan Gallery's annual members' *GEMS* exhibit returns this year to the Gallery's Middle Room. This show is a favorite of members and visitors alike. **NOTE: This is not a juried show.**

SCHEDULE:

Sunday, October 4: Online submissions open on this date. Online submission to this exhibition must be received at www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin/ **before dropping off artwork. Even though not a juried show, all works must be submitted through the online portal.**

Sunday, October 18: Works must be shipped or delivered to Bryan Gallery before or on this date, **no later than 5pm**. Works can be delivered in person or shipped to the gallery (at the artist's expense).

Wednesday, Oct. 28: Exhibition opens to the public

Sunday, January 3: Last day of exhibition

Artists can begin to collect their work Sunday, January 3, 2027. If unable to collect unsold works during this time, you can contact the gallery to schedule a time to collect. To arrange your pickup with the Gallery, call 802-644-5100 or info@bryangallery.org. Out of town artists should provide arrangements with the gallery for the return shipping of their artwork.

ELIGIBILITY: Member artists are guaranteed a maximum of **three works** for GEMS (image size 8"x10" or smaller). Bryan Gallery reserves the right to deny any work considered offensive, inappropriate, or sexual in nature. Works must be 2-dimensional. Portraits will not be accepted. Exhibiting artists are required to become a member of Bryan Memorial Gallery to have your work exhibited. **All works must be available for sale.**

- SPECIFICATIONS:** Artwork must be suitably framed, with hanging cable installed on the backs of the paintings. **Sawtooth or clip hangers are not allowed.** Unframed, “gallery wrapped” canvases, with a depth of 1.5” or greater and with the edges painted, are acceptable.
GEMS: Image sizes for GEMS must not exceed 8”x 10” unframed, and outside frame dimensions must not exceed 14”x 16”.
- HOW TO SUBMIT:** Artists may submit a **maximum of three works for GEMS.** Entries must be presented through the Gallery’s online submissions process www.bryangallery.org/artistsadmin . **Though automatically guaranteed in the show, all GEMS are to be submitted online for administrative purposes.**
Photo Specs: All photos must be **properly cropped, with proper lighting; no shadow or frame. Please photograph before framing behind glass to avoid reflection or glare. iPhone photos are acceptable.**
- TAGS:** Artists must attach TAGS to the back of the accepted works. Tags are available at the gallery’s website:

Please have your work labeled prior to dropping off at the gallery.
- RECEIPT FORM:** When delivering or shipping your work, please include a completed receipt form. The form can be found on the gallery’s website:

- INSURANCE:** The utmost care is taken in the handling of all artwork; however, the Bryan Gallery does not assume responsibility for losses or damage to artwork.
- SALES AND COMMISSIONS:** The Bryan Gallery Commission rate is 50/50.
The Bryan Gallery retains 50% of the total sale price for any painting sold, with the artist receiving the other 50% of the sale of his/her work. The Gallery remits commission checks to artists via postal mail.
- UNSOLD PIECES:** All artwork must be removed from the walls on the dates specified.
